Adani Power Rajasthan Limited (hereinafter called the 'Owner' / 'APRL'), a wholly owned subsidiary of Adani Power Limited, is operating and maintaining 2x660 MW coal based Thermal Power Plant located at Village: Kawai, District: Baran, Rajasthan, India (hereinafter called the 'Plant') is hereby inviting Expression of Interest (EOI) from interested and eligible parties for providing service for "Hiring of Vehicles total Eleven (11) nos. vehicles including AC Innova-Crysta, AC Bolero, AC Marazzo, AC Tempo- Traveler 17-Seater & Non-AC Pick-up Jeep (Mahendra Bolero pickup 05 seater) for 2X660 MW Kawai Thermal Power Plant" for period of Thirty Six (36) months i.e. from 01.04.2023 to 31.03.2026" for 2 x 660 MW Kawai Thermal Power Plant, Village: Kawai, Tehsil: Atru, Dist.: Baran, Rajasthan.

Annexure-2 Scope of Work

Details scope of work as below:

- 1. Contractor shall provide a cost effective, comfortable, safe, and secure Vehicles.
- 2. The vehicle shall be diesel operated and shall comply to Emission norms and well equipped with air conditioning system, music system, luxurious interiors, neat and clean seat covers, air suspension, first aid box, air freshener spray, reverse camera / horn and all other accessories that are required to ensure comfort of employees of the Owner.
- 3. The vehicle must be maintained by the Contractor in good and sound working condition, regularly serviced, daily cleaned & freshened with perfumed air freshener, maintained, and equipped with all mandatory safety requirements and fittings. Seats shall be always covered with neat and clean seat covers, the vehicle shall have good quality foot mat and good quality music system required to ensure comfort of the Owner's employees.
- 4. Contractor must deploy vehicle and services that are energy efficient, less polluting, environment friendly and have ecofriendly waste disposal mechanisms.
- 5. The vehicle shall be equipped with following specifications/ features:
 - a) Air Conditioning (AC)
 - b) Neat and clean seat covers
 - c) Music system
 - d) Provision of Mobile charger point for Passengers

- e) Seat belt for every seat
- f) Fire extinguisher
- g) First Aid Box
- h) Should follow Emission norms.
- i) GPRS Tracking system in the vehicle. (Provided by Owner)
- j) Valid Fast Tag with adequate balance in Fast Tag
- k) Reverse Horn / Camera
- I) Vintage of Vehicle- Ageing of vehicles shall be less than 5 years and Permissible KM consideration shall be less than 3,00,000 KMs at any point of time throughout the Contract period for deployed vehicles at site.

(For Non-AC Utility vehicle- a, c & d are not applicable).

- 6. The vehicle deployed by Contractor must be maintained in trouble-free working condition during the Contract Period. If the Vehicle go under breakdown, the Contractor shall provide immediate replacement of equivalent good quality vehicle without any additional cost to the Owner.
- 7. No Private Vehicle shall be allowed for making the alternate arrangements. If the Contractor fails to make the alternate arrangement, then the Owner reserves the right to make the alternate arrangement. The additional cost incurred by the Owner towards making such alternate arrangement (at actuals) along with applicable penalties shall be recovered from the Contractor's monthly RA bills.
- 8. The vehicle shall be deployed on all calendar days of the month including Sundays and holidays during the Contract Period on 12 & 24 hours/day basis as per the schedule prescribed by the Owner's OIC.
- 9. Requirement of Vehicles:
 - a) AC Innova Crysta at Kawai plant with fix 2500 KM/month/vehicle on 24 Hrs basis, Qty. 2 nos. vehicle.
 - b) AC Innova Crysta at Jaipur Office with fix 2500 KM/month/vehicle on 24 Hrs basis, Qty. 1 no. vehicle.
 - c) AC Bolero at Kawai plant with fix 4500 KM/month/vehicle on 24 Hrs. basis, Qty. 4 nos. vehicle.
 - d) AC Marazzo at Kawai plant with fix 4500 KM/month/vehicle on 24 Hrs. basis, Qty. 02 nos. vehicle.
 - e) AC Tempo Traveler (17 seater) at Kawai plant with fix 4500 KM/month/vehicle on 24 Hrs. basis, qty. 01 no. vehicle.
 - f) Non-AC Mahindra Bolero Pickup, 05 seater /Camper, Non-AC with fix 2500 KM/ month/ vehicle on 12 Hrs. basis, Qty. 01 no. vehicle.
- 10. Deployment of Driver for AC Inova Crysta, AC Bolero, AC Marazzo, AC Tempo Traveler Vehicles & Non-AC Utility Vehicles:
 - a) For 12 Hrs. /day working: 01 no. Driver.
 - b) For 24 Hrs. /day working: 02 nos. Drivers on rotation basis.

Deployment on 24 Hrs. basis with necessary arrangement of separate Driver for each shift in day & night time.

- 11. Driver shall always be remain available with the vehicle during the working hours.
- 12. Contractor shall supervise delivery of services and co-ordinate with Owner's admin representative daily for smooth functioning of its transport services, maintaining shift logbook, shift schedule, proper records of vehicles, gate pass formalities and Statutory compliances and for all kind of support.

- 13. Contractor will deploy sufficient staff to operate vehicles as per Contract.
- 14. Contractor shall depute one (01 nos.) Supervisor 24X7 at their own cost for supervising delivery of services and co-ordinate with Owner's admin representative on a daily basis for smooth functioning of its transport services, maintaining shift logbook, shift schedule, proper records of vehicles, gate pass formalities and Statutory compliances and for all kind of support.
- 15. Supervisor shall be available at Owner's site throughout the Contract period. Supervisor shall be always available on mobile phone for the entire duration of operation during the day & night for smooth co-ordination of the Services. Sitting arrangement of Supervisor shall be provided by Owner.
- 16. Contractor shall provide a full-fledged Helpdesk facility for 24 hours at Owner's Plant premises by both supervisors. The Helpdesk staff must be adequately trained in transport management techniques.
- 17. Contractor shall ensure on-time arrivals of Owner's employee and shall establish a travel management system to ensure that the fleet is well kept, and its statutory compliance fulfilled while utilizing the fleet to its optimal capacity.
- 18. Contractor must engage drivers with a proven performance track record and with no criminal record. The drivers must ensure proper behavior and maintain appropriate dress standards. Owner shall have the unquestionable right to request the Contractor to replace any staff whose performance, in its opinion, is found unsatisfactory, especially while performing duties for Owner.
- 19. Drivers shall not pick up any unauthorized passenger while performing duties for Owner.
- 20. Operation and function of vehicle and drivers shall be governed by Motor Vehicles Act/Motor Vehicles Rules, and these shall be the responsibility of the Contractor. The vehicle must be Taxi Passing (Commercial vehicle) only.
- 21. The expenses incurred towards oil & lubricants, salaries of drivers & other staff, vehicle maintenance, insurance charges, RTO Tax, PUC charges, municipal taxes, license fee, registration charge and other charges are in the scope of the Contractor.
- 22. The base rate of diesel for monthly hiring charges and extra KM charges shall be Rs. 93.75/liter. Price base is Baran Price on dated 09.01.2023 (Taking online from https://www.mypetrolprice.com)
- 23. The unit rates (charges for monthly hiring, running KM and extra KM) shall remain firm during the tenure of the Contract period, except for revision in HSD price & RTO tax.
- 24. Any additional vehicle required during the year shall also be deployed on existing rate & terms and condition.
- 25. Fuel Price Increase/ Decrease: If diesel rate increases/ decreases w.r.t base rate (i.e. Rs. 93.75/liter), financial implication shall be as per the below mentioned formula:

Financial Implication = Actual running KMs during the month (km) / Mileage of Vehicle (km/ltr.) X Average Change in diesel rate for the subject month w.r.t base rate (Rs. 93.75/liter)

- 26. Mileage of vehicles shall be considered as follows:
 - a) AC Innova Crysta 10 KM/Ltr.

- b) AC Bolero 12 KM/Ltr.
- c) AC Marazzo 12 KM/ Ltr.
- d) AC Tempo Traveller (17 seater) 8 KM/ Ltr.
- e) Non-AC Mahindra Bolero Pickup, 05 seater /Camper, Non-AC 13 KM/ Ltr.

If diesel price increases w.r.t base price (i.e. Rs.93.75/Liter), the Contractor shall invoice for the resultant financial implication under separate head in their monthly RA bills. If diesel price decreases w.r.t base price (i.e. Rs. 93.75/Liter), the Owner shall deduct the resultant financial implication from monthly RA bills of the Contractor. Illustration for calculation of financial implication due to change in diesel price during the month shall be attached at Annexure-6.

Contractor shall raise separate invoice along with supporting documentary evidence for reimbursement of additional expenses due to increase in HSD prices which shall be reimbursed under separate head after due certification by the Owner's Officer In-charge (OIC).

- 27. GPRS tracking system in the vehicle:
 - a) All vehicles should have GPRS tracking system and GPRS will be provided by Owner.
 - b) Monthly total running Kilometers considered for billing based on the GPRS tracking system.
 - c) Speed Limit will be cross checked with the GPSR tracking system for the violation of speed limit and penalty shall be applicable for violation of speed limit
- 28. Contractor shall submit the monthly billing as mentioned below:
 - a) Monthly Hiring charges for vehicle- Monthly Charges inclusive of hiring of vehicle with Driver and all expenses like fuel, Maintenance, lubricants, Mobil oil, maintenance charges, RTO passenger tax, other municipal taxes, license fees, registration charges, Salary of driver etc.
 - b) Extra Running KM (beyond fix KM) charges: The extra running KM rate shall be invoiced separately at actual as certified by Owner's OIC. The running KM rate shall be inclusive of diesel and other charges.
- 29. Toll Tax/charges & parking charges (wherever applicable) shall be reimbursed at actual against submission of documentary proof.
- 30. The Contractor shall comply with all the provision of Motor Vehicle Act/ Motor Vehicles Rules 1988 with latest amendments. The Contractor shall be responsible for meeting all statutory obligations with regards to registration of vehicles, road permit, route permit, comprehensive insurance, road tax, fitness certification of the vehicle etc. The Contractor shall also obtain permission for running the vehicle on hire/ contract basis from RTO. The vehicle shall always carry valid original documents i.e. driver's license, tourist permit, insurance papers, PUC, fitness certificate etc. The copies of all the papers shall be submitted by the Contractor to the Owner before commencement of the Contract.
- 31. The Contractor shall ensure that their drivers must always possess valid LCV license issued by RTO and should be fully familiar with the road, driving conditions and applicable highway codes.
- 32. The vehicle shall be driven as per the speed limit of Traffic Rules/Owner's Safety Dept. and as specified / notified by the RTO authorities from time to time. Parking of vehicle should be done as per the traffic rules Owner or its officials travelling by the vehicle provided by the Contractor will not at all responsible, if driver is penalized for such offence/s or caught for any antisocial or illegal acts of the driving.
- 33. The Contractor shall ensure that their staff deployed under the Contract are always in proper uniform (comprising of pant, shirt, shoes & name badge) as directed by the Owner's OIC and have good and courteous manners and drive the vehicles safely and shall have fair knowledge of Hindi language.

In the event of misbehavior of drivers (unsafe/ rash driving, unnecessary arguments, misconduct etc.), the Owner reserves the rights to expel the driver under intimation to the Contractor.

- 34. The Contractor shall be personally liable for the conduct, acts and safe driving by its staff. In all circumstances, the Contractor shall be liable to pay all damages, claims & costs arising on account of conduct or faulty driving by their drivers. The Contractor shall make good any loss / damage caused to the movable / immovable property of the Owner.
- 35. The center of operations of all the vehicles shall be at "Adani Power Rajasthan Limited", 2 x 660 MW Kawai Thermal Power Plant, Village: Kawai, Tehsil: Atru, Dist.: Baran, Rajasthan starting, and end point will be as per instruction of Owner's OIC. However 01 no. AC Innova-Crysta (24 Hrs.) shall be deploy at APRL Jaipur office and shall be operate as per instruction of Owner's OIC.
- 36. All statutory permissions regarding vehicles & staff deployed under the Contract and their operation shall be obtained by the Contractor. The Contractor shall be liable for all the liabilities arising out of their noncompliance of various statutory obligations as applicable.
- 37. The vehicle deployed by the Contractor shall be pollution free & display a valid 'Pollution under Control' certificate issued by Rajasthan Motor Vehicle Department.
- 38. The staff deployed by the Contractor shall not be employees of the Owner and shall not have any claim whatsoever on the Owner and shall not act detrimental to the interest of the Owner.
- 39. The Contractor shall be responsible for meeting all statutory obligations of their driver or their staff about payment of salary/ wages, Bonus, PF, ESIC/ workmen compensation, overtime, PF, Gratuity and leave etc. as provided in various labour laws etc.
- 40. The Contractor shall arrange for accommodation and local conveyance of their staff at their own cost. No accommodation shall be provided in the Owner's premises for the drivers & cleaners, if any deployed by the Contractor.
- 41. The Contractor shall provide a logbook in which their drivers shall correctly enter travel particulars such as departure time of vehicle from one point to another, time of arrival at destination, total kilometers covered for the journey etc. The logbook with all the entries shall be submitted to the Owner's OIC on periodic basis/ on demand for verification & certification. Certified copy of the logbook shall be submitted by the Contractor along with monthly RA bills at the end of every month.
 - In case, the signatures mentioned above are not obtained, such journey shall not be counted for the purpose of payment. If during any trip, it is noticed that the driver has not met the time schedule given to him or that he has caused inconvenience to the employees/passenger, applicable penalty shall be deducted from the Contractor's monthly RA bills.
- 42. Uniform: Contractor shall provide 2 pairs of uniform which includes pant & shirt as approved by Owner. Contractor must ensure that deployed employees are wearing uniform properly & regularly during the duty hours. (l.e., proper uniform in good condition properly pressed & well-dressed condition).
- 43. The vehicle must be cleaned every day.

- 44. The Contractor shall ensure that the drivers must possess valid HCV/LCV License (AS APPLICABLE) issued by RTO and should be fully familiar with the road, driving conditions and applicable highway codes.
- 45. The manpower employed by the Contractor shall wear uniform and name badge, which is provided by the Contractor and the Contractor shall be responsible for the discipline of his manpower. The manpower deployed by the Contractor is not employees of the Owner and shall not have any claim whatsoever on the Owner and shall not act detrimental to the interest of the Owner. The manpower shall have to follow the security regulations as directed by Security and firefighting dept. of the Owner.
- 46. The statutory permissions relating to the work site shall be taken by the Owner and all statutory permissions regarding the mobilization / demobilization of related equipment (if any) and their operation shall be obtained by the Contractor. Therefore, the Contractor shall be liable for the liabilities arising under various statutory obligations at that point of time under circumstances as specified above.
- 47. The Contractor shall comply with all the provision of Motor Vehicle Act 1988 with latest amendments.
- 48. The Contractor shall during the execution of the work insure all its employees, equipment and all assets against destruction or damage by fire, earthquake, theft, flood, cyclone, etc., to its full insurable value and keep insured till the completion of this Contract / issuance of taking over certificate. Copy of such policy shall be submitted to the Owner with the fitness certificate. Further the Contractor shall take Workmen's Compensation Policy and keep the same valid till the end of completion of this Contract till the issuance of completion certificate. All insurances shall be affected with an insurance company and terms approved by the Owner. The Contractor shall take the insurance against all risks of loss or damages for full replacement value of Contractor's equipment, third party liability insurance, insurance against injury to persons and damage to surrounding property (comprehensive general third-party liability cover) and keep the insurance covers valid till the end of the Contract / issuance of taking over certificate.
- 49. The Contractor shall be solely responsible either for any injury, damage, accident to the workman employed by the Contractor or for any loss or damage to the equipment/property in the areas of work because of negligence/carelessness of its manpower.
- 50. Sub-letting / Sub-contracting the work is not permissible under any circumstances.
- 51. The Contractor shall be responsible for any sort of injury to persons, animals, or things and for all damages to the property of the Owner / others due to carelessness, negligence, and mishandling etc. of equipment and / or machinery on the part of Contractor while carrying out the services under this Contract.
- 52. The Contractor shall ensure that list of all the workers proposed to be employed for working at site is forwarded to the local police for verification of antecedents.
- 53. The Contractor shall take all requisite Work permit from the Owner's Officer-In-Charge before commencing any work in the existing / operational area.
- 54. 12 Hrs/day vehicles' shift timing schedule will be 08:30 Hrs. to 20:30 Hrs.
- 55. Contractor has to manage transport services round the clock (24 Hrs.) at site including a) Transport help-desk operation, b) Vehicle deployment operation, c) maintenance /breakdown. For satisfactory operation, the contractor shall appoint there representative to carry out transport helpdesk and vehicle deployment services. No extra payment shall be claimed against this support service.

- 56. Contractor has to provide daily report and analysis thereof for all vehicles as per requirement (format/MIS) given from Owner.
- 57. Drivers, helpers and cleaners are required to punch on daily basis during IN TIME & OUT TIME at main gate. Owner of the vehicle should not drive the concerned vehicle.
- 58. Parking of vehicles to be ensured at designated place only.
- 59. Owner of the vehicle should not drive the concerned vehicle. Vehicle should be driven by a valid driver only.
- 60. As per Owner requirement top luggage carrier is to be provided.
- 61. Tempo Traveler vehicle (17 Seater passing) is required with luggage carrier and luggage dickey.
- 62. All kind of applicable insurance including ESIC policy shall be in contractor's scope as applicable for Distt. Baran Rajasthan.
- 63. All statutory norms like PF/Bonus/ESIC/Medical examination etc to be strictly followed by contractor for the resources deployed by contractor at their cost.
- 64. Respective contractor will deploy supervisor in all shifts for monitoring their 24 hours vehicles & to ensure smooth deployment.
- 65. Filling of diesel from any place will be under contractor scope. Whenever driver go out for refilling of diesel during working hours, it is required to take permission from Admin Department office In-charge & no extra payment or kilometer/any other consideration will be given for diesel refilling outside or elsewhere. It is expected that contractor will ensure the diesel refilling before vehicle reports at site.
- 66. Night station charges shall be applicable when vehicle deploys outstation duty like Jaipur, Delhi, etc. but Kota, Baran and other nearby areas are not included/covered for night station charges. For Jaipur vehicle night station charges shall be applicable when vehicle deploys outstation duty (Outside Jaipur).
- 67. The vehicle deployed should have spare wheel and necessary tools and tackles all the time.
- 68. The Contractor shall at all times indemnify and keep indemnified the Owner and its officers & representatives against all third-party claims, whatsoever (included but not limited to property losses/damages, personal accident, injury or death of persons of any sub-Contractor and damage to property of the Owner) and the Contractor shall at his own cost and initiative at all times till the successful completion of the Contract
- 69. Period, maintain comprehensive insurance policies in respect of all the insurable liabilities under Motor Car Act, Workman's Compensation Act, Natural Hazard, Riot/Arson, Fatal Accident Act, Personal Injuries Act, Third party Liability Act, Emergency Risk Insurance Act and/or other Industrial Legislation from time to time in force in India with insurance Company as required by the Government Rules and such policies shall be of the amount and limits as generally specified by respective insurance company/Government from time to time.
- 70. The unit rates are inclusive of PF, WC policy, bonus, leave wages, ESI / Workmen Compensation, Gratuity, canteen facility, PPE, uniform, Tools & Tackles, consumables (HSD, Jubricants etc.), Maintenance & servicing of vehicles, cost of necessary tasking, mobilization & de-mobilization charges,

lodging, travel expenses, loading, unloading & handling of material, other charges, overheads, Bank charges, and all other costs as applicable for the completion/ commissioning of the Works / Facilities.

- 71. Working hours for each Vehicle shall be as specified in Price Schedule (Annexure-4) excluding lunch & tea breaks, for 30/31 days in a month.
- 72. All the Manpower of Contractor shall be biometrically enrolled, verified against blacklisting database, medically checked and imparted safety training before issuance of entry pass.
- 73. The Manpower to be deployed by the Contractor at Site shall be interviewed by the Company prior to deployment & is subject to Company's approval.
- 74. The Contractor shall depute minimum 30% (thirty percentage) Manpower from local area. In case, Contractor is unable to deploy the required local Manpower, due to unavoidable reasons, they shall have to take NOC from the Owner's Plant HR department.
- 75. Contractor has to ensure that at least 70% of the Manpower (including 100% of the senior staff), deployed at Site should have been on the rolls of Contractor for past two (2) years.
- 76. The Contractor has to provide full assistance to Company on emergency services.
- 77. The Contractor shall ensure compliance with safety as per Company's "Annexure-8 Safety Requirements" manual, Quality and other statutory requirements and assist the Company in implementation and maintaining of IMS, 5S and other initiative.
- 78. Personnel Protective Equipment (PPE) such as uniforms, Ear Plug, helmet, shoes, masks, Reflecting jacket, Ear Plugs, Safety goggles & etc. shall be in the Contractor's scope.
- 79. Contractor shall provide vehicle on all days of the month during the Contractual period. Contractor will be allowed for vehicle maintenance once in a month with prior permission of Owner's Officer In-charge. As replacement Contractor shall provide another vehicle of similar model & vintage without any extra charge for vehicle and driver.

80. Contractor Safety scope shall be as below:

- a. Safety is the prime concern and violation of safety or ignorance will not allow. Contractor shall follow Employer's safety standards.
- b. Safety of contractor's manpower at the work premises will be contractor's responsibility. All safety system/practices must be adhered to in consultation with our Safety Officer, before commencing the work at Owner's plant and offices. Contractor has to follow all rules of safety.
- c. Following measures need to be done.
 - I. Training will be given to the Supervisors and workman.
 - II. Near miss incident reports will be monitored and analyzed for action and prevention.
 - III. Unsafe acts will be taken up immediately for rectification and prevention.
 - IV. All required PPE's of Trainers will be in Contractor Scope on It's cost.
 - V. All tools and tackles to be ensured as defect free tools and certified by Third party responsibility. All tools and tackles should be certified by competent person approved by CIFB Rajasthan. This clause shall be for eligible cases only.
- d. All safety system/practices must be adhered to in consultation with Employer's Safety Officer, before commencing the work at Owner's plant. Contractor has to follow all rules of safety strictly to full fill all safety requirements as per attached "Safety requirements", "Job specific safety requirements" and applicable rules e.g. The Factory Act, State Factory Rules, etc.

- e. All the contractor staff shall wear three PPEs (mandatorily) i.e. Safety Helmet, Safety Shoes & Reflective Vest and shall carry four PPEs i.e. Hand Gloves, Safety Goggle, Ear Plugs & Nose Mask as per Employee safety guidelines. The contractor shall ensure use of all safety PPEs by their engineers and other staff at site. Contractor has to provide safety helmet, hand gloves, safety shoe, gum boot, safety goggle, safety belts, ear plugs, nose mask and reflective jacket to workmen. All the PPEs should be of Owner's approved make only. Workman without using safety device shall not be allowed to do the work & shall be treated on absent.
- f. All safety items and appliance required during work will be provided by the contractor to his staffs.
- g. Contractor will have to follow all the safety norms during this job.
- h. Contractor has to replace PPEs if consumed.
- i. Driver/ Operator age preferably be not less than 25 years with at least 5 years of valid driving experience of heavy/ LMV vehicle as per applicability.
- j. Tractor is not allowed for any type of manpower transportation.
