INTRODUCTION

Ganeshpur coal block has been a part of the coalfield of North Karanpura within Central Coalfields Limited command area in the state of Jharkhand,

The Ganeshpur block is located in the western part of the North Karanpura Coalfield. It covers an area of 2.37 Sq.Km. is bounded by Lat.23°48'06" & 23°49'11" N and Long. 84°51'00" & 84°52'30" E. It falls under the Balumath Block of Latehar District of Jharkhand State.

It had been allotted to M/s Tata Steel Ltd., as leader and M/s Adhunik Power and Natural Resources Ltd., as the associate by the Ministry of Coal, Govt. of India, vide letter no. 13016/27/2008-CA-I dated 28th May, 2009 for end use of coal in their thermal power projects.

The Supreme Court of India vide judgment dated 25th August, 2014 read with its order dated 24th September. 2014 has cancelled the allocation of 204 coal blocks and issued directions. The nominated authority in accordance with provisions of the Coal Mines (Special Provisions) Second Ordinance, 2014 and the Coal Mines (Special Provisions) Rules 2014 conducted the auction of the mines.

Ministry of Coal vide Vesting Order under clause (b) of sub-rule (2) of rule 7 and sub-rule (1) of rule 13 and Order no. 104/27/2015/NA dated 22nd April, 2015 allocated the Ganeshpur I Opencast Coalmine Project of 4 MTPA (normative) & 5.5 MTPA (Peak) to M/s GMR Chhattisgarh Energy Limited as the successful bidder.

Subsequently, M/s GMR Chhattisgarh Energy Limited obtained transfer of Environmental Clearance vide MoEF&CC letter no. J-11015/251/2010-IA.II (M) dated 10.06.2015

GMR Chhattisgarh Energy Limited has been acquired by Adani Power Limited & the name of the company has been changed to Raipur Energen Limited with effect from 20th August 2019. It is to further note that Raipur Energen Limited is 100% subsidiary of Adani Power Limited.

Raipur Energen Limited has also obtained EC transfer letter of Ganeshpur I Opencast Coal Mine from MoEF&CC vide letter no. J-11015/251/2010-IA.II (M) dated 22.10.2020

Ganeshpur I Opencast Coal Mine has **not started mining operation**.
