withdrawn day
after declaration

THE MEDICAL Counselling Committee (MCC) withdrew the result for Round-1 of the NEET-PG counselling-2022 a day after declaring it, saying that there were problems in the information uploaded by some institutes. The Committee has now opened 'choice filling' afresh for the PG aspirants.

"... the provisional result for Round-1 of PG counselling... is being withdrawn since some of the PG DNB institutes did not complete their address profile on the portal due to which their seats were not visible when 'state filter' was applied by the candidates during choice filling, even though their seats were included in the seat matrix of Round-1 and were available for choice filling," a notice by the MCC read.

The notice says that students who are satisfied by their choices need not make any changes as the software will pick the choices they had made.

Cabinet okays Rs 10,000 cr for facelift of three railway stations

Redevelopment work to be taken up at New Delhi, Ahmedabad, Mumbai stns

THE GOVERNMENT has approved the redevelopment of major railway stations using money from its own coffers instead of going for public private partnership (PPP), finally bringing a clarity on the funding mechanism for these mega projects.

The Union Cabinet chaired by Prime Minister Narendra Modi on Wednesday cleared Rs 10,000 crore for the redevelopment of railway stations at New Delhi, Mumbai (Chhatrapati Shivaji Maharaj Terminus), and Ahmedabad in poll-bound Gujarat.

The works will be taken up under the engineering, procurement and construction (EPC) model and the money will solely come from the government coffers, Railways Minister Ashwini Vaishnav said while briefing the media on the Cabinet decision.

"Railways caters to middle class and lower middle class so any extra burden on passengers is not good. So, it has been decided to invest budget money in the Railways. It is a conscious decision to redevelop all these stations under the EPC model," he said.

The Indian Express had earlier reported the government's intention

to directly fund the station redevelopment works—a priority project monitored by the Prime Minister's Office—rather than wait for PPP model to take off. Sources were of the view that while the bigger stations will be funded by the government, exploring source for funding of smaller stations is underway. Vaishnav said 199 stations,

each with an annual footfall of 50 lakh and more, have been earmarked for redevelopment in the first phase that will cost Rs 60,000 crore.

The minister said that tenders for 47 stations are out, and the target is to complete the redevelopment of New Delhi station in three-and-a-half years. The other two railway stations will be redeveloped in two-and-a-half years, he said, adding that the tenders will be out in about 10 days, he said.

This brings the station development project, stuck in inordinate delays over the several years, to a full circle. The ambitious exercise has toyed with several modes of funding and execution, including PPP, in the past with little success. There was also an Empowered Group of Secretaries headed by the NTI Aayog CEO to push this project.

The stations' design principles will be to integrate with multi-model connectivity and also provide top-class amenities, he said.

PM Modi to arrive today on two-day Gujarat visit

PRIME MINISTER Narendra Modi will arrive Thursday on a two-day visit to Gujarat where he will lay foundation stones and inaugurate projects worth Rs 29,000 crore in the state which includes launch of Phase-1 of Ahmedabad Metro worth Rs 12,900 crore and the 36th National Games.

The PM will also visit the Navratri garba festival at the GMDC grounds in Ahmedabad being hosted by the state government, after the pandemic.

On Thursday, Modi is expected to arrive at Surat in morning where he will inaugurate and dedicate projects worth Rs 3,400 crore. This includes Phase-1 of road infrastructure works and the main entrance of Diamond Research and Mercantile (DREAM) City, which is expected to become a hub for diamond trading. He will also lay the foundation stone of Phase-II of the project.

Among other projects, the PM will lay the foundation stone of biodiversity park, which is being built on 87 hectares of land from Dr Hedgewar Bridge to Bhimrad-Bamroli Bridge. He will also inaugurate Khoj Museum at Science Centre in Surat.

Thereafter, the PM will travel to Bhavnagar, where he will lay

the foundation stone and inaugurate multiple developmental initiatives worth over Rs 5,200 crore. He will lay the foundation stone of the World's First CNG Terminal and of brownfield port at Bhavnagar which will be developed at cost of Rs 4,000 crore.

Modi will also inaugurate the Regional Science Centre in Bhavnagar, which is spread over 20 acres and has been built at a cost of around Rs 100 crore. He will also inaugurate package 7 of Sauni Yojna link 2, 25 MW Palitana Solar PV Project, APPL Container (Aawadkrupa Plastomech Pvt. Ltd.) project; and lay foundation stone of projects including package 9 of Sauni Yojna link 2, Chorvadla Zone water supply project, among others.

In the evening, the PM will travel to Ahmedabad to inaugurate the 36th National Games at Narendra Modi Stadium. He will also address athletes from across the country taking part in the National Games. During the event, he is slated to inaugurate the world class "Swamim Gujarat Sports University" in Desar.

On September 30, Prime Minister will flag off Gandhinagar-Mumbai Vande Bharat Express at Gandhinagar station and travel on the train from there to Kalapur railway station. This will be the third Vande Express and the first of the upgraded version of the train.

At around 11.30 am, the PM will flag off the Ahmedabad Metro rail project and will take a Metro ride from Kalapur station to Doordarshan Kendra metro station. At around 12 noon, Prime Minister will inaugurate Phase-1 of Ahmedabad Metro project at a public function at Ahmedabad Education Society in Ahmedabad. This comprises about 32 km of East-West corridor from Apparel park to Thaltej and North-South corridor between Motera to Gyaspur.

Around 5.45 PM, the PM will lay the foundation stone and dedicate various projects worth over Rs 7,200 crore in Ambaji in North Gujarat. Around 7 pm, Modi will perform darshan and puja at the temple and attend maha aarti at Gabbar Tirtha at 7.45 pm.

During the event at Ambaji, PM Modi will dedicate and lay foundation stone of over 45,000 houses built under PM Awas Yojana. He will also lay the foundation stone of Taranga Hill—Ambaji—Abu Road New Broad Gauge Line and development of pilgrimage facilities at Ambaji temple under Prasad scheme. The new rail line will benefit lakhs of devotees visiting Ambaji. Other projects whose foundation stone will be laid includes construction of the runway and associated infrastructure at Air Force station, Deesa; Ambaji Bypass Road among others.

Past promises remain on paper as PM makes new ones now: Gohil

CONGRESS NATIONAL spokesperson Shaktisinh Gohil on Wednesday said that the people of Bhavnagar will welcome Prime Minister Narendra Modi on Thursday but reminded the ruling Bharatiya Janata Party (BJP) that a number of projects announced by Modi are remaining on paper.

"According a welcome to guests is the tradition of Bhavnagar. However, we also expect that today Prime Minister will also give an account of why nothing has happened about big announcements he made during his visits to Bhavnagar..." Gohil said in a release.

The Congress leader, who is a

native of Bhavnagar and a sitting Rajya Sabha member, enlisted a number of projects, which, he claimed was announced by Modi as Gujarat chief minister and had not taken off. According to Gohil, in 2008, Modi had announced that an earthen bund will be built across the Gulf of Khambhat as part of Kalpasar project along with gas and waterlines that connect Bhavnagar with Surat.

"Years have passed since but even a single brick of Kalpasar has not been laid," said Gohil, adding an RTI reply had revealed that the government spent Rs 18 lakh on printing invitation for the 2008 event held in Jawahar Maidan.

Modi is scheduled to visit Bhavnagar on Thursday to lay the foundation stone of world's first CNG terminal being built at a cost of Rs 4,024 crore at Nava

Bandar and around two dozen other projects worth hundreds of crores of rupees.

The Congress leader also said that the announcements to develop industrial estates in Ghogha, Talaja and Vallabhipur, making Mithi Virdi (Sartanpar) port a Central port, setting up a marine university in Bhavnagar, building a shipyard at a cost of Rs 2,800 crore, a diamond park, modernising Mahuva port and setting up 46 schools in coastal areas of Bhavnagar remain on paper.

"Projects announced for Bhavnagar in the past have not taken off and the Prime Minister is visiting (Bhavnagar) during election times. We expect that he will not make only announcements but will also give an account of projects announced in the past," said Gohil.

China envoy: Emergency response phase since Galwan incident over

THE "PHASE of emergency response since the Galwan Valley incident" has "basically come to an end" and the border situation is now switching to "normalised management and control", China's ambassador to India, Sun Weidong, has said.

Sun has also linked the Taiwan question and Tibet-related issues by expressing hope that India can "properly handle issues related to China's core interests". This is a significant framing, as Beijing has, for the first time, sought to link its redline on Taiwan with the India-China border situation.

Speaking at a virtual event to celebrate the 73rd anniversary of the founding of the People's Republic of China on Tuesday, organised by the Chinese embassy in New Delhi—the speech was released on Wednesday—

Sun said, "The current border situation is overall stable. The phase of emergency response since the Galwan Valley incident has basically come to an end, and the border situation is now switching to normalised management and control."

"The Chinese side is willing to maintain dialogues via diplomatic and military channels with the Indian side, and together seek solution to the border issues in a peaceful manner through dialogue and consultation," he said. "It is hoped that the Indian side can properly handle issues related to China's core interests, including [the] Taiwan question and Xizang-related issues," he said. The Chinese refer to Tibet as "Xizang".

Sun also said, "According to the consensus reached in the 16th Round of China-India Corps Commander Level Meeting, the Chinese and Indian troops in the area of Jianan Daban have completed disengagement."

Mundra port drug haul case: NIA arrests Bengal-based businessman

New Delhi: The National Investigation Agency (NIA) has arrested a West Bengal-based businessman in connection with the September 2021 Mundra port drug haul case. This is the 26th arrest in the case pertaining to the operations of one of the largest international drug smuggling syndicates, run by Afghan brothers Hassan Daad and Hussain Daad.

In a statement, the NIA said Sushanta Sarkar, a businessman from Malda district of West Bengal, was arrested for his alleged involvement in the illegal supply of heroin into India for supporting terrorist activities.

"Sarkar had ordered a heroin-laden shipment of semi-processed talc from Afghanistan to India via Iran in November. He used his firm 'Jesus Christ Impex' for this and he further transported the consignment to the firm of another accused, Kabir Talwar, in Delhi," the NIA claimed. ENS
